### No Uniform Day:

Special “no uniform” days are announced in the school newsletter or parents will be notified through our Instant Alert System. Special theme costumes, relaxed dress or “non-uniform” apparel may be permitted as appropriate for special events. No sleeveless tank tops, midriff tops, short shorts or short skirts will be permitted. Inappropriate tee shirts are prohibited. No frayed hemlines on shirts, **jeans**, skirts or pants. School uniform gym shoes are required at all times. Heels, platforms, or flip flop sandals are not permitted. We ask that students and parents use good judgment. Abuse of the dress code will result in loss of the privilege.

Once a month, a “**Charity No Uniform Day**” will be posted on the calendar. Any child who wishes to donate \$1.00 (or more) will be allowed to come to school out of uniform, provided they follow the proper dress code of “No Uniform Day.” Student Council will chose which charity the money will be given to. The American Cancer Society, Day Star, Pregnancy and Family Life Center, Jump Rope for Heart, are examples of such charities.
