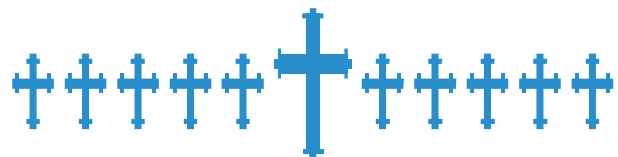
COMING EVENTS

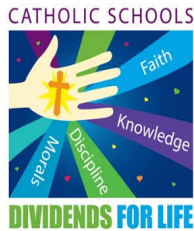
YEARBOOK UPDATE
